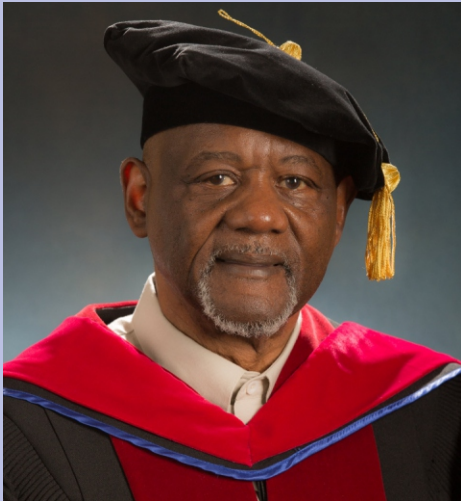

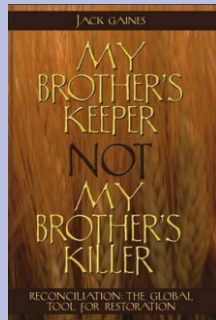

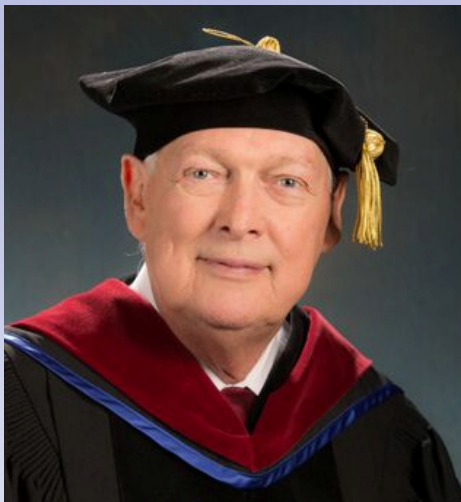
Cherished Alumnus that have gone home to be with the Lord



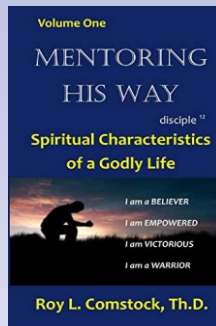
DR. JACK GAINES SR. (1945 – 2020) of Chesapeake, Virginia, transitioned to eternal glory in the early morning hours of March 23, 2020. Dr. Gaines graduated from Primus University of Theology in 2008. He faithfully served on the Primus Board of Regents for over 10 years. He was the Author of *My Brother's Keeper not My Brother's Killer*, and an



Internationally recognized speaker. Jack was a humble man, with a heart for God. Whatever was important to God was important to Jack. He was also a humanitarian. He just loved people from all over the world and every walk of life. In his early years, Jack became one of the first African American pitchers in Major League Baseball. In his later years, he dedicated his life to serving in the ministry as an Assistant Pastor, Missions Elder and as an Ambassador for Global Reconciliation.



DR. ROY COMSTOCK went home to Glory on March 17, 2020. Roy is the Founder of *Christian Mentors Network*, Author of *Mentoring His Way*, and a 2014 Graduate of Primus University of Theology. Roy's road to accomplishment was long and hard, having grown up in 14 different foster homes and living the street gang life. After finding Christ, he became a successful business man and leader in his church community. Unfortunate



circumstances led to his corporate downfall and he spent some time in prison. Roy received special permission from the governing Chaplin to lead Bible study, where he taught how to receive Christ and let Christ have true control of your lives in spite of past sin. Roy documented his studies which became his first book, "*Mentoring His Way*". Roy's vision was to "*Change the world, by challenging every believer to disciple 12 in their lifetime and to teach them to do the same.*" 2 Timothy 2:2: "*Now teach these truths to other trustworthy people who will be able to pass them on to others.*"



DR. SHARON HENNING, went home to be with The Lord May 7, 2020. Dr. Sharon and Dr. Don Henning are The Authors and Teachers of "*The Making of a Chaplain*" curriculum. They both received their Doctor of Theology Degree from Primus University of Theology in 2010. Pastor Sharon served Dream City Church, Phoenix First Assembly, for over 30 years in the Special Needs and Compassion Ministries, and was a leading authority on reaching Special People and Seniors. Robert Hamilton Owens

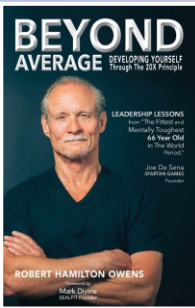
In this issue we are highlighting Minister Robert Owens from California and Chaplain Milt Weber from Arizona.

Milt's was instantaneously healed of Polio in 1952, then, during his military service in Vietnam he became an eye witness to many more miracles.

He entered ministry as a worship leader, and professor in 1980, he has developed curriculum in Church History, Comparative Religions and Galatians.

Since 2016 he has focused his ministry on oppression healing and deliverance, introduced to him by Dr. Scott Bitcon, a 2017 Alumnus of Primus University of Theology.

Milt has a heart for those suffering with PTSD, and has designed his Doctoral Dissertation as a how to book on overcoming post traumatic stress.
